Fungus/Pest/Fertilizer: All turf at Beach CDD was sprayed with herbicide to help attack winter weeds, and promote grass growth

Maintenance: Regular monthly maintenance was serviced to all turf areas inside Beach CDD. All ornamental grasses were trimmed down on Meritage Blvd to promote new growth for the spring.

Ornamental grass trimming has been started in pocket parks and will continue throughout the winter season.

Annuals: Weekly winter annual maintenance was serviced to all annual beds, including dead heading flowers and weed pulling.

Irrigation Report: Irrigation heads were serviced as needed. The irrigation has been turned off in pocket parks in attempt to save water usage while the grass is in a dormant stage

Beach Community Development District ("Client") has requested that we prepare certain computations related to the above-described Bonds for the period ended November 3, 2023 ("Computation Period"). The scope of our engagement consisted of the preparation of computations to determine the Rebatable Arbitrage for the Bonds for the Computation Period as described in Section 148(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code"), and this report is not to be used for any other purpose.

In order to prepare these computations, we were provided by the Client with and have relied upon certain closing documents for the Bonds and investment earnings information on the proceeds of the Bonds during the Computation Period. The attached schedule is based upon the aforementioned information provided to us. The assumptions and computational methods we used in the preparation of the schedule are described in the Summary of Notes, Assumptions, Definitions and Source Information. A brief description of the schedule is also attached.

The results of our computations indicate a negative Cumulative Rebatable Arbitrage of \$(1,266,589.42) at November 3, 2023. As such, no amount must be on deposit in the Rebate Fund.

As specified in the Form 8038G, the calculations have been performed based upon a Bond Yield of 6.9863%. Accordingly, we have not recomputed the Bond Yield.

The scope of our engagement was limited to the preparation of a mathematically accurate Rebatable Arbitrage for the Bonds for the Computation Period based on the information provided to us. The Rebatable Arbitrage has been determined as described in the Code, and regulations promulgated thereunder ("Regulations"), as applicable to the Bonds and in effect on the date of this report. We have no obligation to update this report because of events occurring, or information coming to our attention, subsequent to the date of this report.

NOTES AND ASSUMPTIONS

- 1. The issue date of the Bonds is November 4, 2013.
- 2. The end of the first Bond Year for the Bonds is November 3, 2018.
- 3. Computations of yield are based upon a 30-day month, a 360-day year and semiannual compounding.
- 4. We have assumed that the only funds and accounts relating to the Bonds that are subject to rebate under section 148(f) of the Code are shown in the attached schedule.
- 5. For investment cash flow purposes, all payments and receipts are assumed to be paid or received, respectively, as shown in the attached schedule. In determining the Rebatable Arbitrage for the Bonds, we have relied on information provided by you without independent verification, and we can therefore express no opinion as to the completeness or suitability of such information for such purposes. In addition, we have undertaken no responsibility to review the tax-exempt status of interest on the Bonds.
- 6. We have assumed that the purchase and sale prices of all investments as represented to us are at fair market value, exclusive of brokerage commissions, administrative expenses, or similar expenses, and representative of arms' length transactions that did not artificially reduce the Rebatable Arbitrage for the Bonds, and that no "prohibited payments" occurred and no "imputed receipts" are required with respect to the Bonds.
- 7. Ninety percent (90%) of the Rebatable Arbitrage as of the next "computation date" ("Next Computation Date") is due to the United States Treasury not later than 60 days thereafter ("Next Payment Date"). (An issuer may select any date as a computation date, as long as the first computation date is not later than five years after the issue date, and each subsequent computation date is no more than five years after the previous computation date.) No other payment of rebate is required prior to the Next Payment Date. The Rebatable Arbitrage as of the Next Computation Date will not be the Rebatable Arbitrage reflected herein but will be based on future computations that will include the period ending on the Next Computation Date. If all of the Bonds are retired prior to what would have been the Next Computation Date, one hundred percent (100%) of the unpaid Rebatable Arbitrage computed as of the date of retirement will be due to the United States Treasury not later than 60 days thereafter.
- 8. For purposes of determining what constitutes an "issue" under section 148(f) of the Code, we have assumed that the Bonds constitute a single issue and are not required to be aggregated with any other bonds.

NOTES AND ASSUMPTIONS (cont'd)

- 9. The accrual basis of accounting has been used to calculate earnings on investments. Earnings accrued but not received at the last day of the Computation Period are treated as though received on that day. For investments purchased at a premium or a discount (if any), amortization or accretion is included in the earnings accrued at the last day of the Computation Period. Such amortization or accretion is computed in such a manner as to result in a constant rate of return for such investment. This is equivalent to the "present value" method of valuation that is described in the Regulations.
- 10. No provision has been made in this report for any debt service fund. Under section 148(f)(4)(A) of the Code, a "bona fide debt service fund" for public purpose bonds issued after November 10, 1988, is not subject to rebate if the average maturity of the issue of bonds is at least five years and the rates of interest on the bonds are fixed at the issue date. It appears and has been assumed that the debt service fund allocable to the Bonds qualifies as a bona fide debt service fund, and that this provision applies to the Bonds.
- 11. The proceeds of the Series 2013 Bonds were used for the following purposes: (a) to finance a portion of the cost of acquiring, constructing and equipping certain assessable improvements in the District (the "Project"); (b) to fund deposits to the Series 2013A Reserve Account and Series 2013B Reserve Account in the amounts of the Series 2013A Reserve Account Requirement and Series 2013B Reserve Account Requirement, respectively; (c) to pay capitalized interest on the Series 2013 Bonds through November 1, 2014; and (d) to pay the costs and expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Series 2013 Bonds.
- 12. All proceeds of the Bonds are spent. The Series 2013B portion of the Bonds matured on May 1, 2017, but the Series 2013A portion of the Bonds is still outstanding as of November 3, 2023, and thus remains subject to arbitrage compliance.
- 13. Article 1 amendment to First Supplement dated October 1, 2020, states that the amount on deposit in the Series 2013A Reserve Account shall no longer apply. The Series 2013A Reserve Account Requirement shall mean Zero Dollars.

DEFINITIONS

- 1. *Bond Year*: Each one-year period that ends on the day selected by the Client. The first and last Bond Years may be shorter periods.
- 2. *Bond Yield*: The yield that, when used in computing the present value (at the issue date of the Bonds) of all scheduled payments of principal and interest to be paid over the life of the Bonds, produces an amount equal to the Issue Price.
- 3. *Allowable Earnings*: The amount that would have been earned if all nonpurpose investments were invested at a rate equal to the Bond Yield, which amount is determined under a future value method described in the Regulations.
- 4. *Computation Date Credit*: A credit allowed by the Regulations as a reduction to the Rebatable Arbitrage on certain prescribed dates.
- 5. *Rebatable Arbitrage*: The excess of actual earnings over Allowable Earnings and Computation Date Credits.
- 6. *Issue Price*: Generally, the initial offering price at which a substantial portion of the Bonds is sold to the public. For this purpose, 10% is a substantial portion.

RESOLUTION 2024-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE BEACH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ADOPTING AN AMENDED GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023, PROVIDING FOR APPROPRIATIONS; ADDRESSING CONFLICTS AND SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2022, the Board of Supervisors of the Beach Community Development District ("**Board**"), adopted Resolution 2022-16 providing for the adoption of the District's Fiscal Year 2022/2023 annual budget ("**Budget**"); and

WHEREAS, the District Manager, at the direction of the Board, has prepared an amended Budget, to reflect changes in the actual appropriations of the Budget; and

WHEREAS, Chapters 189 and 190, *Florida Statutes*, and Section 3 of Resolution 2022-16 authorize the Board to amend the Budget during Fiscal Year 2022/2023 or within sixty (60) days following the end of the Fiscal Year 2022/2023; and

WHEREAS, as a result of payments to the District's landscape maintenance provider being sent to an erroneous address for landscaping services which occurred in Fiscal Year 2022/2023, the actual expenses of the District's General Fund exceeded the Districts actual revenue for the Fiscal Year;

WHEREAS, although this error was discovered after sixty (60) days following the end of the Fiscal Year 2022/2023, the Board finds that it is in the best interest of the District and its landowners to amend the Budget to reflect the actual appropriations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE BEACH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

1. BUDGET AMENDMENT.

- a. The Board has reviewed the District Manager's proposed amended Budget, copies of which are on file with the office of the District Manager and at the District's Records Office, and hereby approves certain amendments thereto, as shown in Section 2 below.
- b. The amended Budget attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein by reference as further amended by the Board is hereby adopted in accordance with the provisions of Sections 190.008(2)(a) and 189.016(6), *Florida Statutes*;

provided, however, that the comparative figures contained in the amended Budget as adopted by the Board (together, "**Adopted Annual Budget**") may be further revised as deemed necessary by the District Manager to further reflect actual revenues and expenditures for Fiscal Year 2022/2023.

- c. The Adopted Annual Budget shall be maintained in the office of the District Manager and the District Records Office and identified as "The Adopted Budget for the Beach Community Development District for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, as amended and adopted by the Board of Supervisors effective January 15th, 2024."
- **2. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the Beach Community Development District, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending September 30, 2023, the sums set forth below, which sums are deemed by the Board of Supervisors to be necessary to defray all expenditures of the District during said budget year, to be divided and appropriated in the following fashion:

- 3. **CONFLICTS.** This Resolution is intended to amend, in part, Resolution 2022-16, which remains in full force and effect except as otherwise provided herein. All terms of Resolution 2022-16 that are not amended by this Resolution apply to the Adopted Annual Budget as if those terms were fully set forth herein. All District resolutions or parts thereof in actual conflict with this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, superseded and repealed.
- **4. SEVERABILITY.** The invalidity or unenforceability of any one or more provisions of this Resolution shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining portions of this Resolution, or any part thereof.
 - **5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution shall take effect as of January 15, 2024.
